

Leisurecraft Outdoor Sauna Maintenance Checklist

Follow this easy maintenance guide to maximize the life of your Leisurecraft sauna.

Regular Cleaning

- ☐ Wipe down benches, walls, and floors after each use.
- ☐ Use a mild, non-abrasive cleaner to remove sweat and bacteria.
- ☐ Leave the door open after each session to ventilate moisture.

Wood Care

- ☐ Rinse exterior wood with a hose.
- ☐ Apply Livos stain to protect exterior from weathering.
- ☐ Wipe interior surfaces with mild soap and water.
- ☐ Clean windows with a glass cleaner.
- ☐ Lightly sand benches if they become rough.
- ☐ Vacuum interior surfaces as needed.

Heater Maintenance

- ☐ Remove ashes from wood-burning stoves regularly.
- ☐ Check the chimney for soot buildup.
- ☐ Vacuum dust from electric heaters.
- ☐ Replace sauna rocks annually for optimal airflow.

Ventilation Check

- ☐ Ensure all air vents, especially near the heater, are clear and unobstructed.

Wear & Tear Inspection

- ☐ Tighten any loose screws.
- ☐ Check and tighten door hinges as needed.

Winter Protection

- ☐ Remove snow and ice from the sauna roof.
- ☐ Use a weatherproof cover if the sauna will be unused for long periods.
